- Ensuring all recruitment of coaches and volunteers include checks to assess their suitability and appropriate level of skills to work with children
- Mitigating risks in physical and online environments to promote safety and wellbeing
- -Reporting and acting on any breaches of code of conduct, complaints or concerns appropriately and treat them seriously and with respect.
- Reporting and responding to any incidents of abuse or neglect towards teens.
